

Antigonish Farmers' Market Association Food Vending Checklist

Before selling any food product (raw or prepared), a food vendor must complete the following requirements and sign the checklist once complete. Anyone selling food at the Antigonish Farmers' Market is required by the AFMA to have taken a Food Handler's Safety Course.

- I have applied for and received my annual Public Market Permit and will have with me at all times at the Antigonish Farmers' Market.
- I have spoken with the Food Safety Specialist (FSS) to determine what practices I must adhere to in order to satisfy Food Safety Regulations.
- I will be selling food at the AFMA and have taken the Food Handler's Safety Course as required by the AFMA
